This policy explains what happens to your information when you visit this website or get in touch. It is written to be read, not to be skimmed past.

Who is responsible

This site belongs to Nat Wozniak, an independent web designer. If you have any question about your information, email hello.natwozniak@gmail.com and it comes straight to me — there is nobody else here.

What this website collects

Nothing.

There are no contact forms, no newsletter sign-up, no analytics, no tracking pixels and no advertising tools. The site sets no cookies of its own, so there is no cookie banner to dismiss.

Two things load from outside the site and are worth naming honestly:

- Google Fonts, which supplies the typefaces. Requesting a font sends your IP address to Google.
- The example websites shown in the portfolio frame, which are hosted alongside this site and behave the same way.

What my hosting provider records

Like nearly every website, the server keeps standard access logs — IP address, browser type, pages requested and the time of the request. These exist to keep the site running and secure. They are not used to build a profile of you and are not combined with anything else.

What happens when you email me

If you email me, I hold what you send: your name, your email address and whatever you tell me about your project. I use it to reply and, if we work together, to run the project.

I do not add you to a mailing list, and I do not pass your details to anyone else unless the law requires it.

Enquiries that do not turn into work are deleted within twelve months. Where we do work together, project correspondence is kept for six years, which is the period tax and accounting rules require.

Where your information is held

Email is handled by my email provider. Files and correspondence are stored on my own computer and in my cloud storage. All of it is protected by strong passwords and two-factor authentication.

Your rights

Under UK and EU data protection law you can ask me to:

- tell you what information I hold about you
- correct anything that is wrong

- delete what I hold, where there is no legal reason to keep it
- stop using your information for a particular purpose
- send you a copy of what you gave me

Email hello.natwozniak@gmail.com and I will respond within thirty days. There is no charge.

If you are unhappy with how I have handled your information, you can complain to the Information Commissioner's Office at ico.org.uk, or to your national data protection authority.

Changes to this policy
